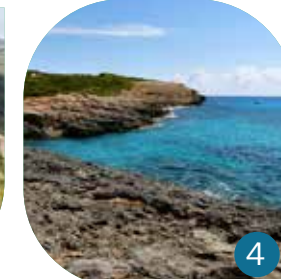
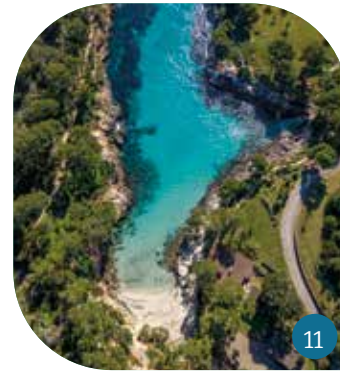
## Nature and breathtaking landscapes

Discover a true paradise of biodiversity and spectacular landscapes on the Felanitx coastline. The coast combines cliffs, secluded coves and natural viewpoints that invite you to stop and gaze out at the sea in peace. From strategic points such as Puig de Sant Salvador, the historic Castell de Santueri or the Sanctuary of Mare de Déu de Sant Salvador, you can enjoy panoramic views that cover the entire municipality, from the rural interior to the blue line of the Mediterranean.

For lovers of nature and the marine world, Felanitx offers a wide range of beaches and coves with crystal-clear waters that are a delight for swimming, snorkelling or simply relaxing by the sea. And for birdwatchers, the Son Navata wetland is a must-see: an area of great ecological value where you can observe a surprising variety of bird species in complete freedom.

# Interior of Felanitx

## Living nature and rural landscape

Discover the interior of Felanitx, a landscape of great beauty and serenity, where nature is alive and changing throughout the year. Fields of almond trees, vineyards and centuries-old olive trees stretch as far as the eye can see, creating a mosaic of colours that invite you to walk, cycle or simply enjoy the calm of the Migjorn.



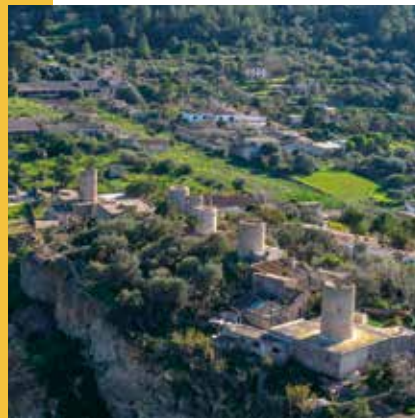
## Son Navata wetland

One of the most valuable natural areas in the municipality is the Son Navata wetland, an enclave of great ecological interest where numerous species of birds congregate. It is a small paradise for birdwatchers and nature lovers, with viewpoints from which to quietly observe the rich biodiversity of this wetland habitat surrounded by farmland.



## Windmills: silhouettes of the past

Scattered throughout the municipality, the old flour mills are an integral part of the Felanitx landscape. Some still stand on hills near the town centre and the Calvari road, while others are located among the fields. They bear witness to the agricultural activity of times gone by and are visual landmarks that help us understand the historical relationship between the wind, the land and farming.



## Inland population centres: the essence of rural life

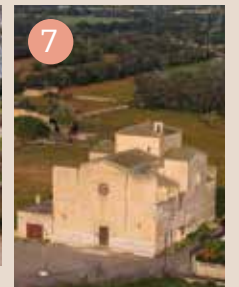
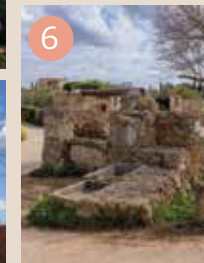
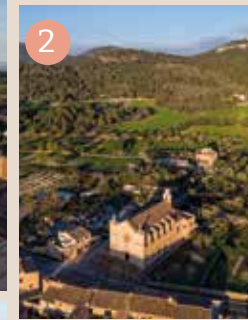
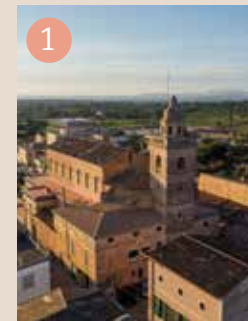
The inland villages of Felanitx keep the most authentic character of the municipality alive:

1. **Cas Concos des Cavaller** – A rural centre with historic houses, surrounded by paths for walking among fields and horse breeders who preserve the tradition of carriage rides.
2. **Es Carritxó** – A town of wide fields and serene landscapes, dominated by the imposing church of Sant Antoni Abat, a landmark in the landscape.
3. **S'Horta** – An agricultural village surrounded by vineyards and farmland, with the church of Sant Isidre and hiking trails connecting to other villages and the coast.
4. **Son Mesquida** – A small village surrounded by olive groves, where the

tradition of producing olive oil with Designation of Origin and high-quality olives is maintained.

5. **Son Negre** – A village clustered around its chapel, ideal for unwinding and the starting point for horse riding routes and activities through fields and scrubland.
6. **Son Proenç** – A peaceful corner with an important vernacular architectural heritage, such as the Font de Son Proenç fountain and the old schools, which explain Mallorca's rural past.
7. **Son Valls** – A haven of peace surrounded by fields and traditional houses.

Each village maintains its own rhythm and offers a different perspective on rural life and the agricultural landscape of Felanitx.



# Mountains: nature, history and panoramic views

The mountainous landscape of Felanitx combines stunning natural beauty with a rich historical heritage. Peaks, cliffs and winding paths invite you to take a leisurely stroll, climb up to viewpoints and enjoy panoramic views that encompass the

entire municipality and much of Mallorca. It is the perfect destination for those who want to enjoy nature, discover places steeped in history and be amazed by spectacular views.

## Puig de Sant Salvador

At an altitude of 509 metres, Puig de Sant Salvador is the highest point in the area and home to the 15th-century Sanctuary of Mare de Déu de Sant Salvador. From the summit, you can see Marina de Llevant, Pla de Mallorca, Serra de Tramuntana and, on clear days, the bay of Alcúdia.

## El Calvari

The Calvari de Felanitx is a 19th-century chapel located at the top of a steep path with a long religious tradition. Along the route, you will see old flour mills, and from the top, you can enjoy magnificent views of the town centre and the surrounding countryside.

## Sa Mola and the Cova de sa Mola

The Sa Mola area is notable for its quarries and unique rock formations. Here you will find the Cova de sa Mola, a small but accessible cave with karst formations that make it an attractive spot for nature lovers and caving enthusiasts.

# Sports: nature in motion

Felanitx is an ideal destination for sports and nature lovers. Throughout the year, you can enjoy outdoor activities: hiking and cycling routes along the coast and inland, kayaking or sailing from the coves, snorkelling and diving in crystal-clear waters, or a round of golf at the Vall d'Or course, with privileged views of the Mediterranean.

## Walking and cycling routes

Felanitx has a network of well-marked trails linking the coast with the mountainous interior and rural villages. You can enjoy gentle walks among vineyards and almond trees, family outings to secluded coves or more demanding routes to the peaks and viewpoints of the municipality. Scan the QR code to access the Felanitx tourist website, where you will find detailed information on all the routes: distance, elevation, maps, points of interest and recommendations for enjoying hiking and cycling, with all the information at your fingertips.



## Sports facilities

The municipal sports facilities in Felanitx offer everyone high-quality spaces to practise sport at any age and level. The Guillem Timoner Municipal Sports Centre has indoor swimming pools, a fitness room, rooms for guided activities and several indoor and outdoor courts. The Toni Peña Sports Centre completes the offer with a central court and paddle courts.

Outdoors, the Es Torrentó – Mariona Caldentey Oliver football field (Felanitx) and the Sa Lleona sports field (s'Horta) allow you to enjoy football and other sports in a family-friendly and sporting environment. Anyone can become a member of the facilities and take advantage of all their benefits.

# Active tourism: adventure in nature

Felanitx invites you to enjoy outdoor adventures thanks to a wide range of active tourism options. Specialised companies organise activities that allow you to discover the municipality in an exciting and safe way.

- **Golf** – At the Vall d'Or Golf course, you will play among pine trees and vineyards with spectacular views of the Mediterranean.
- **Water sports** – Snorkelling and diving trips among Posidonia meadows, kayaking excursions and sea activities.
- **Horse riding** – Horse riding routes along rural paths and inland landscapes, ideal for connecting with nature at a leisurely pace.
- **Boating** – Sailing experiences or boat trips to explore the coastline and discover coves and cliffs from the sea.

A range of activities that make Felanitx the perfect destination for combining nature, sport and adventure.
